

**TOWN OF CLARESHOLM

BYLAW # 1466**

A Bylaw of the Town of Claresholm to amend Bylaw #1416 being a bylaw for the control of dogs and;

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary from time to time to make additions and amendments to existing bylaws;

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act the Council of the Town of Claresholm enacts as follows:

1. Change:

SECTION:

20. f) If the owner of the dog does not claim the animal after three (3) working days, the Bylaw officer may allow another party to adopt the said dog upon collection of all boarding fees accrued.

Add:

SECTION:

20. g) If after three (3) working days the animal is not claimed by the owner or is not adopted, the veterinarian and the Bylaw Officer at their discretion may have the animal euthanized.


