TOWN OF CLARESHOLM PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BYLAW # 1480

A bylaw of the Town of Claresholm in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw #1225 being a Bylaw to control cats within the Town.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and proper pursuant to the provision of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 2000 M-26, as amended, that the Council of the Town of Claresholm shall issue a Bylaw to amend its existing cat bylaw.

NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Municipal Council of the Town of Claresholm duly assembled does hereby enact:

1. Bylaw #1255 shall be amended as follows:

Addition:

g) "Running at Large" means a cat found on any public street, lane, alley or other public place in the Town or is on private property without the permission of the occupant or owner thereof.

Change:

3. A cat owner, whose cat or cats are or become a public nuisance, or are running at large, is guilty of an offence.

Change:

- 4. "...where said animal shall be held for a period of three (3) working days." "If not claimed said animals shall be euthanized or otherwise disposed of."
- 2. Bylaw #1225 is hereby amended.
- 3. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of final passage.

Read a first time in Council this 11th day of September 2006 A.D.

Read a second time in Council this 25th day of September 2006 A.D.

Read a third time in Council and finally passed in Council this day of September 2006 A.D.
