If the Town receives a payment by midnight on the night of August 31st, the Town doesn't have access to those funds until they are deposited on the next banking day, just the same as his tax payment. Mr. Manchulenko also feels that his property was unjustly assessed this past year as his assessment went up around 14%. He was in British Columbia at the time when his assessment could have been appealed, and is here now to address the issue.
