

HOW TO READ YOUR WATER METER

The water meter installed in your home registers in cubic meters (M³). A cubic meter of water is equal to 1000 liters or 220 Imperial gallons. The white dials are full cubic meters while the black dials are 1/10's and 1/100's of a cubic meter. The sweep hand registers in liter increments. Each time the sweep hand makes one full revolution, the far right odometer wheel ("2" in this illustration) will increment by 1.



Leak Detector —If all the fixtures are turned off and the triangle is still consistently moving, you have a leak!

Sweep Hand —Each number (.001 / .002 etc) is one liter. A full rotation of the sweep hand will increment the right dial (10 liters)

Right Hand Dial —This number is in 10 liter or 1/100 of a cubic meter increment
